



Executive Director Position

The SID Public Services Association of Columbus, Ohio is in search of an Executive Director to help lead and further develop the Capital Crossroads and Discovery SID organizations. The Executive Director is responsible for overseeing the administration, programs and strategic plan of the organization. Other key duties include fundraising, marketing, and community outreach. The position reports directly to the Board of Trustees.

Capital Crossroads and Discovery Special Improvement Districts were created by property owners in Downtown Columbus to provide services that support a safe, clean, and vibrant downtown. Property owners in each special improvement district (SID) fund the program through assessments, and the board of trustees determines the focus.

Capital Crossroads SID focuses on safety, cleaning, landscaping, homeless outreach, economic research, Downtown C-pass, and the Pearl Market. Discovery SID focuses on safety, homeless outreach, economic research, first-floor graffiti removal, and creative placemaking.

The candidate must possess the ability to create and convey a long-term strategic vision for the special improvement districts. The candidate must have knowledge and experience in building and mentoring a high-performance team in a complex organization with demonstrable skills in developing strong teams and collaborations.

Further requirements include demonstrated experience in working with and maintaining relationships with public entities, local governments and key stakeholders. A history of supporting diversity, equity and inclusion is required. Knowledge of applying for and managing grants and contracts including public and private funding and regulatory bodies. An educational level equal or equivalent to a master's degree in a related field. A minimum of 5 years' experience in working with city and local governments. The ability to communicate effectively with the Special Improvement board of trustees and provide the necessary data needed to allow for informed decisions.
