




Number of Participating Districts in the Study by State



Have you received a Covid-19 vaccination?

















Response to the Pandemic

How do you feel about public mask requirements in your area as we move into the summer season?














Please rate your level of comfort regarding your health with each of the following while still maintaining proper safety precautions:











Did you work remotely part or full time during the last year due to Covid?






Will your workplace resume pre-Covid attendance policies in the future or change the way people work going forward?



When do you anticipate returning to your office or place of work on a regular basis?









Returning to Work

Has your office space been made smaller, or is it likely to be reduced due to changes caused by Covid?




Overall, how safe and secure do you feel visiting downtown today as compared to before Covid?






Transportation






How likely are you to take an overnight leisure trip this summer?




Many people have shopped online more during the pandemic than they did before. Once Covid is no longer a threat, do you think you will:









Vaccine Passports and Sources of Information


You may have heard about the possibility of "Vaccine Passports" that would allow people who have been vaccinated to easily identify themselves. What are your thoughts on the idea?
