23 districts across the U.S. generating results







Number of Participating Districts in the Study by State






Gender and Age

Age of respondent






Vaccinations

Have you received a Covid-19 vaccination?








Local Restrictions & Policies

Regarding local government policies, do you feel the current pace of easing restrictions on indoor dining, movies theaters, special events, etc. in your community is:






Thoughts on Requiring Masks




Summer Expectations

Average Rating and Percent Responding 1 - 4.






Wave 2 vs. 3

Average Rating, 1 = Very uncomfortable, 4 = Very comfortable.






Events

What is your feeling on larger outdoor events happening this summer like concerts, festivals, spectator sports, etc.?







Only 17% want to go back to the office full time



Will your workplace resume pre-Covid attendance policies in the future or change the way people work going forward?






Returning to work

Has your office space been made smaller, or is it likely to be reduced due to changes caused by Covid?








Returning to Downtown

Overall, how safe and secure do you feel visiting downtown today as compared to before Covid?






Coming Downtown

Now thinking about visiting your downtown district for shopping, dining, or leisure, this summer, do you think you will:






Transportation



How likely are you to take an overnight leisure trip this summer?









Many people have shopped online more during the pandemic than they did before. Once Covid is no longer a threat, do you think you will:






Dining Habits Post-Covid

Many people also ordered more takeout and delivery during the pandemic. Going forward, will you order more or less takeout from restaurants?










Two thirds nationwide favor Vaccine Passports


You may have heard about the possibility of "Vaccine Passports" that would allow people who have been vaccinated to easily identify themselves. What are your thoughts on the idea?





But there is no a clear consensus on who should issue them


If there are Covid Passports or "Proof of Vaccination" cards, do you think they should be:






How do you feel about public mask requirements in your area as we move into the summer season?





- People are ready to move toward normal but most still want some precautions
- Most want to ditch their masks outdoors unless they're in a crowd
- Still cautious with indoor sports, concerts, movies, etc. but ready to dine inside





- Pent up demand to attend outdoor events
- Expanded outdoor seating is a big hit.
 84% want some or all changes to be permanent
- Migration to online shopping accelerated and requires ongoing adjustments





- People will travel this summer but most still hesitant to get on a plane
- Road trips likely to continue as preferred vacation mode in short term
- Increase in takeout/delivery will continue past Covid. Raises issue of "cocktails to go"





- Most have safety concerns downtown as property crimes spiked in many districts
- Messaging on safety and events will be key to enticing people back
- Strong support for vaccine passports but no consensus on issuing them
- Optimism is HIGH across the country!
