

Request for Proposal: Craig Street Outdoor Dining

The Pittsburgh Innovation District

Project Overview

The Pittsburgh Innovation District has been awarded funds to construct outdoor dining infrastructure via the Urban Redevelopment Authority's (URA) Outdoor Dining Grant Program. This program provided grant funding towards outdoor infrastructure that allows restaurant activity to occur safely and enjoyably outdoors

The Pittsburgh Innovation District (PID) is seeking the service of a contractor to provide materials, design framework, and resources to fully assemble outdoor dining infrastructure along Craig Street's business district, adjacent to points of interest such as Carnegie Mellon University, the Carnegie Museum of Natural History, and the Carnegie Museum of Art.

These seasonal patios serve as infrastructure and amenities for this critical business district with the Pittsburgh Innovation District.

Scope of Work and Objectives

The scope of work includes designing, constructing, and installing outdoor dining infrastructure at three (3) locations along South Craig Street. The patios will need to be seasonal, non-permanent, able to be disassembled, and resilient to vehicular damage. Patios will ideally have built-in shade structures and planters. Patios cannot exceed twenty (20) feet in length and design between locations must be consistent.

- Awardee will provide all necessary designs, schematics, and blueprints for approval by all government entities as needed
- Awardee will supply all necessary materials to construct dining platforms along Craig Street
- Awardee, in partnership with the Pittsburgh Innovation District, will secure all necessary permits for construction and operations of outdoor dining infrastructure along Craig Street
- Awardee will install outdoor dining platforms along Craig Street

Awardee is expected to submit the following as part of its bid:

1. Company/organization overview
2. Relevant company/organization work experience related to outdoor dining infrastructure
3. Narrative explaining company/organization experience with Oakland neighborhood and City of Pittsburgh/Department of Mobility and Infrastructure permitting and licensing
4. Projected costs for all necessary designs, schematics, and blueprints of outdoor dining infrastructure for three (3) locations on Craig Street

5. Projected costs for all necessary materials to construct three (3) dining platforms along South Craig Street
6. Projected costs to install outdoor dining platforms along Craig Street
7. Company/organization contact
